## 10 MONTHS BEFORE YOUR I DO'S

In general, you can meet with a florist anywhere from a year to six months out. By this point, you've selected your date, venue, gown, and color palette. These components can significantly influence the type of arrangements you ultimately choose. Find a florist whose work you love, and who seems to best understand your wedding style, vision, and budget.

PRO TIP: Have an idea of your budget and how you want your arrangements to look prior to going to your consultation. Pin all those gorgeous flower arrangements you're seeing all over Pinterest.
