HIRE 12 MONTHS BEFORE YOUR I DO'S

Hiring a wedding planner can provide numerous benefits. If you're interested in a full-service wedding planner who can help with everything, it's best to hire them early on. Some couples prefer to book their venue before hiring a planner, which is also a great way to approach your wedding vendor timeline.

*TIP: This is particularly important to know if you choose a day of coordinator or wedding management. For a day of coordinator, their services typically don't start until 30 days before your wedding day. If you want to work with your planner for your full engagement, you may need a "full planning" package.
